MONTHLY PROGRAMS

FOOD HAMPER

We serve approximately 50 households each month. We offer pre-packed hampers or the option to build your own. This includes fresh produce. We ask that households only access the hampers once a month but there is a miscellaneous shelf that can be accessed at any point in the month if needed.

DIAPER AND FORMULA

For households who have small children using diapers and/or formula this program can be accessed once a month.

BREAD DAY

Thanks to a wonderful volunteer with have COBBS Bread Bakery bread and pastries given to us through the End of Day Givings program. We receive the bread in the evening of the first Monday of every month and hand it out the following day (Tuesday) Any leftovers are frozen and handed out alongside the hampers throughout the month.

SEASONAL PROGRAMS

SEND KIDS TO CAMP

Salvation Army has two camps one for children ages 6-9 and one for children ages 10-15. We can send up to 8 kids.

BACK TO SCHOOL PROGRAM

Parents and guardians can register their children for this program. We supply backpacks, school supplies and a few lunch snacks as well. We ask for the children's grades and school to try an ensure that we supply them with grade appropriate materials.

CHRISTMAS HAMPER

Households can start to register for hampers in October and the hampers are handed out in December. For households with children they can receive toys with their hamper.

KETTLES

We have 3 kettles in town. One at Scotia Bank corner, One at Foodland and at the Independent. Volunteers are needed at all three locations throughout the kettle season.

GARDENING
